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1. WELCOME

The 'Centrum voor Reproductieve Geneeskunde' (CRG or Centre for Reproductive Medicine) has been active within the Universitair Ziekenhuis Brussel (UZ Brussel) since 1983.

As a specialized centre in reproductive health care, it has performed groundbreaking work in the development of reproductive techniques and their application. In 2005 we celebrated the birth of the 10,000th baby to be born as a result of treatment performed at the CRG. It was amongst the first European centres to set up IVF treatment in the early eighties and it was at the CRG that IntraCytoplasmic Sperm Injection (ICSI) was discovered and developed.

The medical assistance is not limited to IVF but includes other fertility techniques such as hormone treatment, artificial insemination, treatment of male impotency, sperm extraction surgery, reversal of sterilization, etc. The research and treatments at the CRG also extend to related reproductive complications: repeated miscarriages, hereditary defects of the parents (or one parent), high incidence of twins or triplets, the need for donor material, etc.

These days continuing education is a "must" and lifelong studying has become common. This is the only solution to be and to remain at the top of the research.

In our concern for openness of clinical care and scientific research we developed a unique 1 to 1 training program focused on the practice in a well structured learning environment.

The CRG wants to share its reputation and expertise with any person involved in the science mission and who wants to take up the challenges of scientific progress.

5. CODE OF BEHAVIOUR FOR PARTICIPANTS

- Upon arrival a copy of ID card or passport will be made. He/she will receive a name badge which should be clearly visible throughout the duration of the course or the visit.
- As required in medical practice all patient information is strictly confidential.
- The IVF laboratories and theatres are within protected areas. The rules regarding special clothing, shoe covers, caps will be explained. Personal affairs need to be kept in lockers. Scrubbing of hands and arms is required if hands-on procedures are done. You are expected to make sure that staff can carry out their tasks without any problem. Mobile phones are not allowed. Questions to the staff should be asked when the staff agrees to answer and should not be asked during critical steps of laboratory and clinical procedures.
- The hands-on programme will be offered taking into account the possibilities of the clinical programme of each day.
- UZ Brussel has no insurance for visitors; it is therefore recommended that you have proper insurance coverage.
- UZ Brussel and CRG – CMG expect that workshop attendees and observers will have a responsible attitude during the time period they spend in the UZ Brussel.
